THE CALLIGRAPHY SOCIETY OF SA INC

(extract from the 2016 Constitution)

OBJECTS
The objects of the Society include, but are not limited to:-
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• To foster and promote the appreciation and understanding of calligraphy and handwriting
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• To cater for the needs of its members by sharing information, organizing lectures, workshops, discussion groups, etc. for all levels of competence
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• To form and strengthen relationships between the Society and related associations and crafts.
MEMBERSHIP
Membership is available to any person sympathetic to the Objects of the Society and who agrees to abide by its Constitution. An applicant shall, upon the payment of any membership fees, become a member of the Society.
Membership subscriptions shall be determined by the Annual General Meeting.
Membership shall run for a 12 month period from 1 April to 31 March. Fees will be due and payable in the period 1 April – 31 May each year. Unpaid fees, from 31 May onwards each year, shall lead to loss of membership.
New members may join at any time during a year by paying the full annual fee. A member may resign from membership of the Society by giving written notice to the Treasurer. Fees shall not be refunded to members who resign and resigning members will be held liable for any outstanding monies owed to the Society.
The Management Committee has the power to terminate the membership of any person whose conduct is deemed detrimental to the Society or contrary to the Objects of the Society, and will inform the member in writing of the inappropriateness of their conduct.
